We are called by God to be the light of the world. We are to go forth and show Jesus' love and forgiveness through loving care for all God's creation

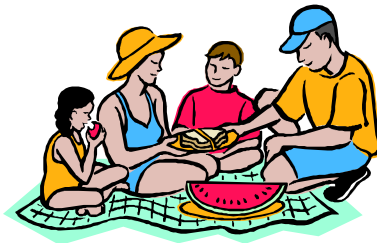
Our Church Picnic will be held on Sunday, June 29 at

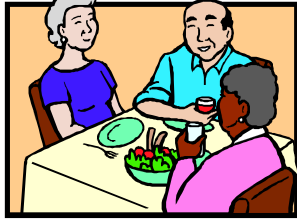
Input Needed
