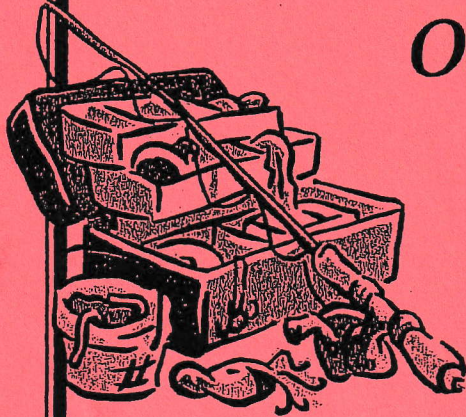
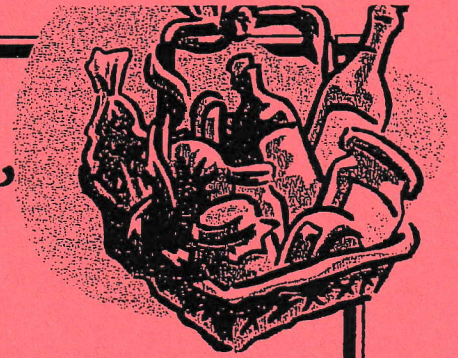

to be a part of this fun project!

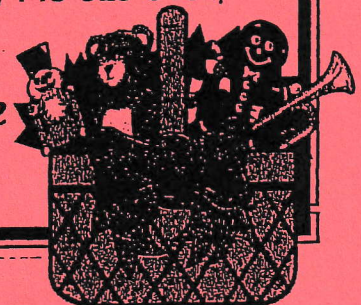
Baskets may be centered around your groups mission

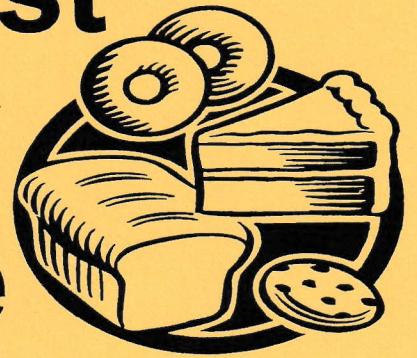

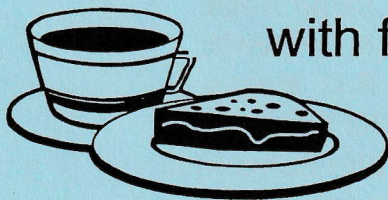

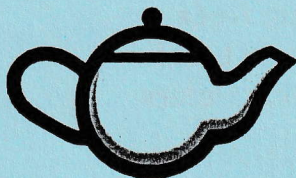
