Pastor's Report: Pastor Lorfeld reviewed, highlighted and expanded items that are published in the 2023 Annual Report. Pastor noted that The <u>Board of Evangelism and Outreach</u> should list Judy Monje as a member. Pastor also noted that some <u>Funeral and Baptismal Records</u> are not complete. The **Mission Statement** is to be revised.

**2024 Budget** as approved by The Church Council was presented. It was noted the 2024 Budget is a "negative" Budget of \$25,000.00. The Budget is a "Working Document" and is revised as needs arise.
